SELECTION OF PROPOSAL FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES  
AS IT RELATES TO THE STABILIZATION AND RESTORATION OF THE FUTURE SITE  
OF THE SELMA VOTING RIGHTS INTERPRETIVE CENTER

*Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc.*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma is the recipient of statutory aid funding in the amount of \$492,000.00 appropriated in 2008 by the United States Congress via the United States Department of the Interior National Park Service to continue the stabilization and restoration work on the site of the future Selma Voting Rights Interpretive Center; *and*

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the procurement requirements as set forth in O.M.B. Circular A-102 Attachment O and the Common Rule as adopted by the State of Alabama and authorized by Resolution No. R180-08/09, the City of Selma advertised its Request for Proposals for Program Administration and Engineering Services in the Selma Times Journal three (3) consecutive weeks beginning April 23, 2009 and ending May 7, 2009; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma Office of Planning and Development accepted proposals for Program Administration and Engineering Services through 5:00p.m on May 11, 2009; *and*

**WHEREAS**, City of Selma Office of Planning and Development has made a selection based on the submitted proposals and wishes to enter into a contract with Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc. to provide services set forth within the proposal for consideration not to exceed 10% of the statutory aid awarded for this project.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

The City of Selma is hereby authorized to enter into a professional services contract with Goodwyn, Mills and Cawood, Inc. for Program Administration and Engineering Services relevant to the stabilization and restoration on the site of the future Selma Voting Rights Interpretive Center; *and*

Consideration for the Program Administration and Engineering services provided under said contract shall be paid from designated Selma Interpretive Center Statutory aid funds provided by United States Congress, passed through the United States Department of the Interior National Park Service and shall not exceed 10% of the total project costs .

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to sign the all appropriate agreements, correspondence, forms and documents necessary to effectuate the same.


